

Questions Regarding the 2011 I&L Contractor Safety Orientation:		
	When must the 2011 Orientation be completed by?	The orientation will be posted by January 1, 2011. Existing contractors have between then and March 31, 2011 to complete the orientation and obtain their new 2011 hard hat sticker.
	Will the 2009 Contractor Safety Orientation satisfy the requirement for the year 2011?	No – the 2009 version of the orientation <i>will not</i> suffice. The content of the 2011 Contractor Orientation was updated to discuss our recent changes to major standards such as Life Critical Safety standards.
	Where can contractors access the 2011 Orientation?	The new 2011 Contractor Safety Orientation will be available via webcast after January 1, 2011 at our external training website: http://training.marathon.com
	How are 2011 Hard Hat Stickers issued?	Each Terminal will receive 30 stickers. For any additional needs, contact your field safety representative. After completing the 2011 Orientation and the review, the contractor should print a certificate of completion to show to Terminal personnel. This certificate is only valid for the 2011 Orientation (previous versions are unacceptable) and contractors cannot share certificates; they must have their own.
	How long are the 2010 Hard Hat Stickers good for?	 All 2010 Contractor Safety Orientation hard hat stickers expire on April 1, 2011. All contractors should complete the 2011 Orientation as soon as feasibly possible, but no later than April 1, 2011 and obtain their 2011 hard hat stickers from a Terminal location.
	What if contractors report issues logging into the training website?	Marathon employees can supply the information at the following link if contractors have difficulties logging in to the training website: http://roadmap.fdy.maplic.com/st/s&P/docs/ContractorSafety/website_log-
